**Exemption from provisions of the *Competition and Consumer
(Consumer Data Right) Rules 2020***


1. The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the Commission), pursuant to section 56GD(2) of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (the Act), hereby exempts

**Discover Energy Pty Ltd (“Discover Energy”)
(ACN 619204750)**

as a data holder, from the following provisions of the *Competition and Consumer (Consumer Data Right) Rules 2020* (the Rules):

- (a) Rule 1.13(1)
 - (b) Rule 1.15(1); and
 - (c) Part 4 of the Rules (the obligation to disclose required consumer data in relation to a consumer data request made by an accredited person).
2. It is a condition of the exemption that Discover Energy must notify the Commission in writing, within 5 Business Days of any of the following events occurring:
 - (a) Discover Energy’s customer numbers reach 10,000 small customers; or
 - (b) Discover Energy makes an application to be an accredited person under rule 5.2 of the Rules.
3. It is also a condition of the exemption that Discover Energy provides a notification to the Commission if it wishes to participate as a data holder in Part 4 of the *Competition and Consumer (Consumer Data Right) Rules 2020* on and from a specified date.
4. In this instrument of exemption, the terms used have the meanings given in the Rules and the Act.
