**Re: National Lotteries and Newsagents Association Limited application for minor variation of authorisation AA1000515 – determination**

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the **ACCC**) has issued a determination in respect of the application for minor variation lodged by the National Lotteries and Newsagents Association Limited (**National Lotteries and Newsagents Association**) on 19 January 2024.

The National Lotteries and Newsagents Association sought a minor variation to the authorisation to amend those parts of the authorised conduct which refer to 'Tabcorp' to be altered to instead refer to 'The Lottery Corporation Limited.'

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached, including a summary of its reasons. For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has decided to grant the minor variation. The ACCC's assessment is set out in Chapter 4 of its determination.

**Application for review**


Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth), a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 18 April 2024. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 19 April 2024.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
