Application for merger authorisation MA1000018 – A.P. Eagers Limited - Determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the **ACCC**) has issued a determination in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by AP Eagers Limited (**AP Eagers**) on 29 April 2019.

AP Eagers sought authorisation to acquire the shares in Automotive Holdings Group Limited (**AHG**) that it did not already own (the **proposed acquisition**).

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached. For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has decided to grant conditional authorisation of the proposed acquisition for 12 months until 16 August 2020. Authorisation is conditional on AP Eagers complying with the court enforceable undertaking provided pursuant to section 87B of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (**Act**) to divest all of its existing new car dealerships and related business sites in the Newcastle and Hunter Valley region. The court enforceable undertaking was accepted by the ACCC on 24 July 2019.

The ACCC requests that AP Eagers advise in writing when it has completed the proposed acquisition.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the Act, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal (the **Tribunal**) for its review of the determination. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of the determination; that is, on or before 15 August 2019. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 16 August 2019.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Tribunal. The Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
