ACCC decision on exemption of GrainCorp's Carrington port facility under the Wheat Code

This letter is to formally notify you that the ACCC has made a decision under clause 5(2) of the Port Terminal Access (Bulk Wheat) Code of Conduct, that GrainCorp is an exempt service provider of port terminal services provided by means of its Carrington bulk grain port facility at Newcastle, as set out in the decision document. The decision is only in relation to that particular facility.

This decision follows from the ACCC's decision in June, under the previous undertaking regime, to reduce the level of obligations applying to the Carrington facility.
