Re: LINX Cargo Care exemption under the Port Terminal Access (Bulk Wheat) Code of Conduct

We advise that LINX Cargo Care (**LINX**) has currently ceased grain loading operations with its mobile ship loader at Flinders Port Berth 29.

The last grain loading operation performed by LINX at Berth 29 occurred between 28 and 30 September 2018.

However, should LINX be approached by a prospective customer for the provision of grain loading services LINX will consider recommencing grain loading operations at Berth 29 in the future and, in such circumstances, will provide written notice to the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (**ACCC**) if and when that was to occur. Accordingly, LINX requests that the ACCC places LINX's exemption under the Port Terminal Access (Bulk Wheat) Code of Conduct on hold.
