### **Consultation on Required Measure 5(D)**

In accordance with clause 5.2 of the Migration Plan, we are writing to notify you that Telstra has now commenced consultation on the proposed Required Measure 5(D) (**RM5(D)**). RM5(D) reflects the disconnection processes that will apply to DDS Fastway, Data Access Radial, Megalink, Frame Relay, ISDN2 and ISDN10/20/30 Direct Special Services and Special Service Inputs that are certified as being used to provide an equivalent product. The development of RM5(D) was triggered by Telstra announcing a national product exit for the relevant products on 20 September 2016.

Please find attached the RM5(D) and our submission in support.

We have advised Wholesale Customers and NBN Co of the consultation on RM5(D). In line with that consultation we also request that any feedback you have on RM5(D) be provided to us by 9 March 2017.
