Price Notification: Airservices Australia Pricing Proposal Notice Pursuant to Section 22(2)(b)(iii) of the Prices Surveillance Act 1983

I am writing in response to the Notice given to the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission on 19 June 2003 by Airservices Australia pursuant to section 22(2)(a) of the Prices Surveillance Act 1983("the Act").

Pursuant to section 22(2)(b)(iii) of the Act, the Commission does not object to Airservices Australia supplying the notified services (terminal navigation and aviation fire-fighting and rescue services) at a specified price, being a price that is lower than the prices proposed in the Notice for a further twelve months; ie until 30 June 2004. A schedule of specified prices that are lower than the prices proposed in the Notice is included as an Attachment to this letter.

I also draw your attention to the requirement under section 22(2)(b)(iii) of the Act to provide the Commission within 7 days after the receipt of this Notice with a further Notice stating that Airservices Australia proposes to supply services "in that locality on the proposed terms and at a price not exceeding the price specified in the Notice by the Commission".
