

What to do if a salesperson calls you or arrives at your door

It's OK to say NO. You don't have to buy anything.

When you receive a cold call, or a salesperson arrives at your door:

I'm not interested. Please leave my home.

I didn't ask you to call me. I'm not interested and am hanging up now.

Don't feel pressured, take your time.

If you're thinking of buying something but need more time to think: I don't want to agree to anything now. I want time to think and discuss this with my family.

Please don't rush me. I want some time to carefully read the contract.

If you decide to buy, you have a 10 day cooling off period.

If you change your mind during this time:

I have rights during the cooling off period and don't have to pay for the product yet.

I have changed my mind and would like to cancel the contract.
