Dear Andrew,

Thank you for your call this afternoon.

We understand from your explanation that Albury Taxis is currently working to draft and implement a new fees structure that will meet the requirements outlined in our letter dated 24 October 2017. We further understand that this involves careful consideration of the business implications to Albury Taxis for any such fees structure, and that its implementation requires that the proper processes and procedures of Albury Taxis be followed, including the convening of an Extraordinary General Meeting of Albury Taxis' members.

You confirmed that, once the new fee structure is in place, Mr Theo Lansdown's Wheelchair-Accessible Taxi be granted full and proper access to all bookings including ordinary and wheelchair bookings. As Mr Lansdown is currently paying the non-member fee, we also consider it appropriate that he be granted access on that basis until the new structure is fully implemented.
