<u>vegetablesWA</u>, representing all the Vegetable Growers in Western Australia with the exception of Kununurra acknowledges the number one issue facing Vegetable Growers today is their lack of influence in the supply chain "Vegetable Growers are price takers for their fresh vegetable products."
