The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission determines, pursuant to section 152AQA of the *Trade Practices Act 1974* (the Act), that the pricing principles and price-related terms and conditions specified in Schedule 1 are to apply to the Domestic Mobile Terminating Access Service, declared under section 152AL of the Act.

Part 1 - Pricing Principles
