

- No regulation of the MDBA
- No charge no regulation
- Private sector operators no proper consideration



Part 4

- Should apply to all member owned
- Information disclosure supported
- Information via web where it exists
- Date should be by start of financial year



Part 5 Operators

Network service plans & consultation

Significant cost imposition

Longer time frames for planning

Flexibility is important

Not something being demanded by customers

Consultation details conflicting

Independent engineer?



Part 6 Operators

- Consultation and analysis should be as undertaken by IPART
- External review
- Sufficient time to for stakeholders to comment
- Public forum for debate, not just written responses
- Include draft determination
- Allow further comment



Part 7 Operators

- Not supported
- Discriminatory pricing mechanism should be used
- Not regulation



Other issues

- How are Government charges for conveyance recovered from transformed customers?
- How can there be certainty about casual or premium use charges?
- Review & member owned



Conclusion

- Member owned operators irrespective of size should be subject to Part 4
- Consideration of change should occur when the rules are reviewed
