To whom this may concern,

Last year Riordan Group Pty Ltd (RGS) applied for and achieved exemption from parts 3-6 of the Port Terminal Access (Bulk Wheat) Code of Conduct 2014 ("The Code") for the loading of bulk grain at Lascelles Wharf, Geelong.

On 15th January 2018 the Department of Agriculture and Water Resources approved RGS to export to grain via a berth at Corio Quay North, Geelong. Approval was granted in part because of the increased traffic and storage of wind turbines at Lascelles Wharf, Geelong.

Due to the flexible nature of mobile bulk loading RGS has the capacity to load from different berths within the Port of Geelong. Accordingly, RGS is requesting exemption from parts 3-6 of the Port Terminal Access (Bulk Wheat) Code of Conduct 2014 ("The Code") be made for the Port of Geelong to avoid any further requests of this nature.
