Implementation?

- No consensus that index-based approaches superior
- Merits of approaches depend on:
 - technical features
 - application and implementation









Integrating policy developments

- Epic Energy judgement (Aug 2002)
- Productivity Commission Review of the National Access Regime (Sept 2002)
- Interim Response (Sept 2002)
- Energy Market Review (Dec 2002)









Reforms are a priority

- Completion of most first round Access Arrangements
- Findings of review processes
- Energy policy developments
- Judicial decisions
- Initial cost-based resets complete less intrusive forms possible









Developing alternative models

- No 'correct' approach
- Choice of access pricing models appropriate
- Market circumstances differ









Information and data

- Different approaches will have different requirements
- 'Backwards to the future' not sustainable
