### **Telstra's ULLS Undertaking and Telstra Efficient Access (TEA) Model**

We refer to Telstra's ULLS Undertaking and the Commission's ongoing consideration of the same.

**Attached** to this correspondence, please find:

- a CD containing version 1.2 of the TEA model (delivered by hand to ACCC's Sydney office together with a copy of this correspondence);
- an engineering study showing the extent of optimisation in the TEA model;
- a document setting out the changes made to version 1.2 of the TEA Model; and,
- a TEA model issues schedule.

As per previous versions of the TEA model, version 1.2 of the TEA model is confidential and may not be made public by the Commission. Version 1.2 of the TEA model is provided to the Commission on the same basis as version 1.0 as set out in Telstra's letter dated 3 March 2008.

Telstra is in the process of sending version 1.2 of the TEA model to those people who have confidentiality arrangements in place for v1.0. Similarly, Telstra will distribute version 1.2.1 of the TEA model to those people who have confidentiality arrangements in place for v1.0.1 as soon as possible.
