Metropolitan Waste and Resource Recovery Group application for authorisation AA1000449 —interested party consultation

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) is currently conducting a consultation process on an application for authorisation received from Metropolitan Waste and Resource Recovery Group (MWRRG), on behalf of itself and 31 councils located in metropolitan Melbourne (together, the **Applicants**).

The purpose of this letter is to invite you, as a potentially interested party, to comment on the application. Please see pages 20-28 the ACCC's publication <u>Guidelines for authorisation of conduct (non-merger)</u> for a summary of the authorisation process and how to make a submission to the ACCC

Application for authorisation

The Applicants propose to jointly procure services for receiving residual waste and related ancillary services (**Landfill Services**). In particular, the Applicants seek authorisation for:

- MWRRG to conduct a collaborative competitive tender process for the procurement of Landfill Services.
- negotiating and executing the contractual framework for the supply of Landfill Services to Participating Councils and
- ongoing administration and management of the resulting contracts.

Related application by MWRRG

This application is in addition to a separate application lodged by MWRRG on 23 July 2019 on behalf of itself and a group of 16 councils located in the south-east of metropolitan Melbourne for the potential procurement of advanced waste processing services. Details about this other application can also be found on the ACCC's website.

Interim authorisation

The Applicants have also requested interim authorisation to enable them to begin the joint procurement process. The Applicants are not proposing to enter into any contracts for Landfill Services before the ACCC issues a final determination in relation to its application.

The ACCC endeavours to deal with requests for interim authorisation quickly. In making an assessment as to whether it is appropriate to grant interim authorisation, the ACCC is not

required to undertake a full assessment of the benefit and detriment likely to arise as a result of the proposed conduct.

The ACCC decides whether to grant interim authorisation on a case by case basis. Should an applicant request interim authorisation, the ACCC will usually consider a range of factors, including:

- harm to the applicant and other parties if interim is or is not granted
- possible benefit and detriment to the public
- the urgency of the matter and
- whether the market would be able to return to substantially its pre-interim state if the ACCC should later deny authorisation.

Request for submissions

The ACCC invites you to make a submission on the likely public benefits and effect on competition, or any other public detriment, from the proposed arrangements.

Submissions in relation to interim authorisation should be provided by 21 August 2019.

Submissions in relation to MWRRG's substantive application for authorisation should be provided by **2 September 2019**.

Please email submissions to adjudication@accc.gov.au with the subject 'AA1000449 – MWRRG (landfill) – submission'.

Submissions, including oral submissions, will be placed on the ACCC's public register subject to any request for exclusion (guidelines are attached).

The ACCC will progress its assessment of the application in a timely manner. An indicative timetable is set out below for your information

October 2019	Draft determination.
October 2019	Public consultation on draft determination including any conference if called.
November/December 2019	Final determination.
