### **Qantas and Emirates application for revocation of authorisation AA1000400 and substitution of new authorisation AA1000625 – interim authorisation decision**

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the **ACCC**) has granted interim authorisation to enable Qantas Airways Limited (**Qantas**) and Emirates and their related bodies corporate (together, the **Applicants**) to continue their coordination under their Restated Master Coordination Agreement, while the ACCC assesses their substantive application for re-authorisation.

The ACCC last authorised the coordination between the Applicants in 2018, with conditions. On 7 November 2022, the Applicants lodged an application for revocation of existing authorisation AA1000400 and substitution of new authorisation AA1000625 (referred to as 're-authorisation'). The existing authorisation is due to expire on 31 March 2023.

Interim authorisation protects the arrangements for which re-authorisation is sought from legal action under the relevant provisions in the *Competition and Consumer Act 2020* (Cth).

A copy of the ACCC's interim authorisation decision is attached and also available on the ACCC's [public register](#).

### **Next steps**

The ACCC is preparing a draft determination which will indicate the ACCC's preliminary views on the merits of the substantive application for re-authorisation. The ACCC will give both the applicant and interested parties the opportunity to provide a further submission on the draft determination before the ACCC issues its final determination.

As noted in the attached decision, the ACCC may review its decision on interim authorisation at any time. The ACCC's decision in relation to interim authorisation should not be taken to be indicative of whether or not final authorisation will ultimately be granted.
