**Australia New Zealand Industrial Gas Association application for revocation of authorisation AA1000516 and substitution AA1000576 – final determination**

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination in respect of the application for re-authorisation lodged by the Australia New Zealand Industrial Gas Association (**ANZIGA**) on 13 September 2021.

For the reasons set out in its final determination, the ACCC has decided to grant authorisation with conditions until 30 September 2022.

**Application for review**

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth), a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 29 December 2021. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 30 December 2021.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
