Qantas Airways Limited and Japan Airlines Co. Ltd – application for authorisation AA1000540 – final determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by Qantas Airways Limited (**Qantas**) and Japan Airlines Co. Ltd (**JAL**) on 18 December 2020.

Qantas and JAL sought authorisation for a Joint Business Agreement in relation to their operations across a range of routes between Australia/New Zealand and Japan.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached, including a summary of its reasons. For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has decided to deny authorisation. The ACCC's assessment is set out in Chapter 4 of its determination.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth), a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 5 October 2021.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
