## Tasmanian Farmers and Graziers Association (TFGA) - CB10000476 - ACCC does not object

The ACCC has assessed the collective bargaining notification (CB10000476) lodged by the Tasmanian Farmers and Graziers Association on 11 December 2020 and does not to object to the notification. Protection from legal action provided by the notification commenced on 25 December 2020.

In addition, the ACCC has decided that it is appropriate for the notification to remain in force for ten years until 10 December 2030. The ACCC's Statement of Reasons is available on <a href="the-public register">the public register</a>.

## Application for review

Under section 101A of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010*, a person dissatisfied with the ACCC's decision in relation to the period of the notification may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal (the Tribunal) for a review of that decision. An application for review must be made to the Tribunal on or before 3 March 2020. The Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia. The ACCC may review a notification at any time if circumstances change, or the ACCC receives further information, such that it is satisfied that the public benefits no longer outweigh the public detriments.
