N10000505 – Caravan Trade & Industries Association Queensland – Final notice to revoke

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the **ACCC**) has decided to issue the attached final notice to the Caravan Trade & Industries Association Queensland (Caravanning Queensland) in relation to Caravanning Queensland's exclusive dealing notification lodged with the ACCC on 3 October 2019.

As a result, from 22 August 2020, Caravanning Queensland will no longer have statutory protection from legal action to engage in the Notified Conduct.

Application for review

Issuing a notice revoking a notification is subject to review by the Australian Competition Tribunal. A person seeking review must lodge an application for review with the Tribunal within 21 days of the ACCC issuing the notice.

An application for review of the ACCC's decision should be lodged directly with the Tribunal. The Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
