Re: Telstra TPG merger authorisation application (MA1000021) – Late submission and report

We refer to your email of 6 December 2022 attaching a submission from Optus and a report from Alix Partners.

In the course of this extremely complex investigation, the ACCC has obtained an enormous amount of material that has been provided by interested parties in accordance with the ACCC's merger authorisation processes, including by your client.

The Competition and Consumer Act 2010 makes clear that the ACCC is able to set a closing date for the receipt of submissions, which allows the ACCC to have sufficient time between the receipt of material and making its determination to enable meaningful consideration of that material. Section 90(6A) provides that the ACCC is not obliged to have regard to material which is received after the closing date for receipt of submissions.

The additional information provided with your email comes so late in the ACCC's consideration of the application that the ACCC may not be able to be take it into account as it works towards making a determination within the statutory period. The ACCC reserves its position in this regard.

We propose placing a copy of this correspondence on the public register. We also propose to provide a copy of this letter to Telstra and TPG's external counsel.
