Elective surgery update. Situation in Victoria – aged care patients

Discussion was had around the gravity of the situation in Victoria, and the enormity of the pressure on the institutions and staff. Comments were made around the remarkable work that the private health sector is doing to help during the pandemic.


Rachel David asked about further measures funds with a large presence in Victoria could undertake to support members.

PHA wants to keep track of what is happening, in particular, what elective surgery has been postponed or cancelled, and the impact on health workers and mental health provision.

Hospitals responded that:

- All elective surgery is taking place around Australia: except in Victoria where only category 1s
 are being done.
- In relation to aged care, it depends on their location as to what help can be offered. As there has been a need to separate COVID patients and non-COVID patients,

- Further examples of the private sector stepping up to help in the COVID crisis.
- There is no shortage of PPE.
