Dear Kaitlin,

The table below contains the required Basic Bank Account (BBA) reporting for the 12-month period to 31 August 2022.

We draw your attention to the reporting for Bank 7 and Bank 9 for this 12-month period which represents an updated response for the following reasons:

- Bank 7 does not meet the BBA definition which extends beyond “no or low fee” accounts and includes the other criteria listed in Banking Code of Practice clause 44B.; and
- Bank 9 has never offered a BBA, as they do not offer a choice of debit card or scheme debit card as required by clause 44B(e) of the Banking Code of Practice.

We have also attached an updated table for the 2021 reporting period which removes specific product names. Please replace the current file with this file for the purpose of public reporting.
