ElectraNet - ACCC access undertaking

I refer to our recent conversation regarding this matter.

By way of background:

- we act for Bluemint Pty Limited ("Bluemint"). Its shareholders are Macquarie Bank Limited, Powerlink Queensland and ABB Group Holdings Pty Limited);
- Bluemint was recently named the successful bidder for the assets of ElectraNet, the South Australian electricity transmission network, as part of the South Australian State Government's ("SA Government") electricity privatisation;
- Bluemint has entered into a business sale agreement with the SA
 Government. At completion of the sale, SA Government will grant 200-year leases of the electricity transmission network to Bluemint;
- completion of the sale/lease transaction is scheduled for 31 October 2000;
- one of the conditions to completion is that Bluemint needs to be registered under the National Electricity Code ("NEC") as a Transmission Network Service Provider. Before NEMMCO will grant such registration, it needs to know that Bluemint has given the access undertaking to ACCC in the form of Schedule 5.8 of the NEC.


